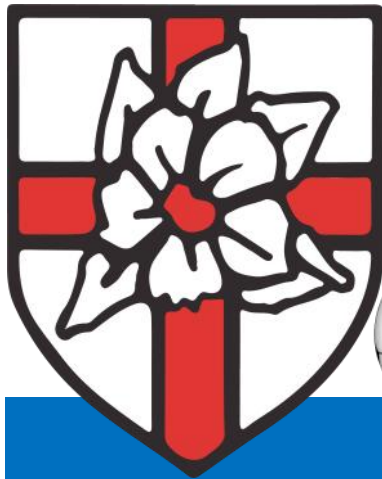

Dear Parents and Carers,

As another busy week comes to a close, I wanted to share a few updates from Summerfield.

We're delighted that Sports Day will now take place this Wednesday after last week's postponement due to the heatwave. Thank you, as always, for your continued support.

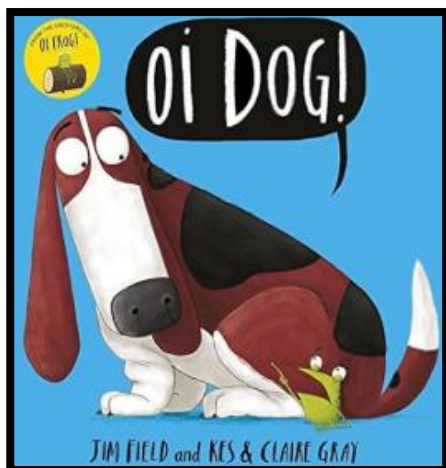

Some of the children have earned their individual green point rewards so we have had children wearing their own clothes, going to the swings for extra play and hot chocolate and a biscuit.

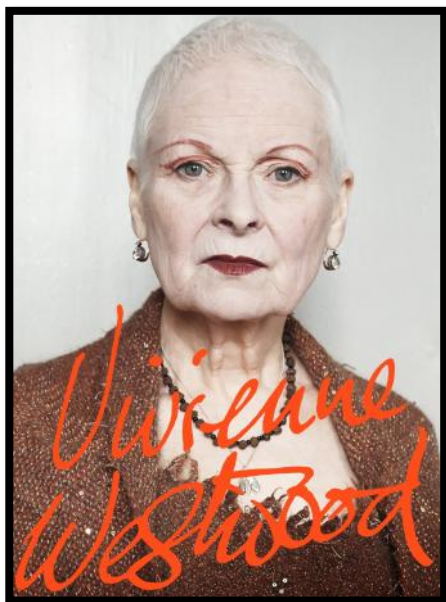
Lastly, as the end of year is approaching we are getting ready to say goodbye to 3 of our Squirrels children as 1 of them will be going to secondary school and 2 of them are

Children were invited to come to school wearing something bright and colourful and also got to enjoy one of Isla's favourite treats, a Jammie Dodger biscuit!

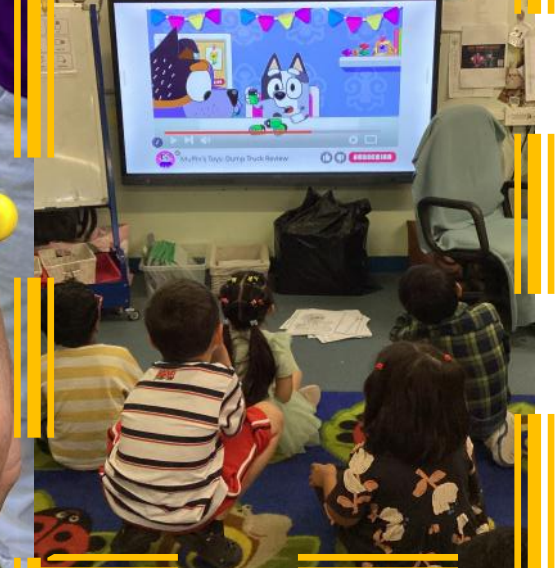
It was a special day.
